**“Post-Acute Care Claim Trends and the Impact on the Expanded Use of Technology”**

Types of claims in post-acute care has remained fairly consistent overtime. Claims tend to be focused on alleged failure to prevent falls, failure to prevent wounds, and failure to prevent medication errors. Allegations of abuse and neglect related to staff (either improperly trained or insufficient numbers) are also common. What is relatively new is the impact that technology is having on the ability of a party to either prove or disprove a claim. We will briefly review claim trends in general, and the impact of going “alarm free”. We will then focus on how utilization and production of an electronic health record can impact a claim; how common area video and private video is impacting claim values; and finally, we will review the growing use of remote monitoring, potential exposure caused by this type of monitoring, and how to mitigate that exposure.

**“Legal Update: The Payroll-Based Journal and Nursing Home Litigation”**

Actual and perceived staffing levels at skilled nursing facilities (“SNFs”) have been the subject of legal and regulatory debate since the 1987 nursing home reforms. The federal government recently provided a new tool—the Payroll-Based Journal (“PBJ”)—which provides detailed daily staffing information for individual SNFs. As a result, media are concentrating on staffing more than ever before, academics may follow suit, and plaintiffs will pursue staffing litigation more vigorously than ever. This presentation will provide SNF owners, operators, and clinicians, relevant information about PBJ and suggest strategies for developing a proactive response to the new challenges it presents.
